The ALN Conference featured the first public presentation by McKinsey of the sequel to *Lions on the Move*, its groundbreaking 2010 report on Africa's economies. *Lions on the move II: Realizing the potential of Africa's economies* is a follow-up report highlighting a USD 4 trillion opportunity to serve fast-growing consumer and business markets.

2014

The ALN Conference hosted the signing of the DIFC Courts' first Memorandum of Guidance with the High Court of Kenya. The DIFC's first MoU with an African country. It took place in the presence of His Excellency Sheikh Nahyan bin Mubarak Al Nahyan, Minister of Culture, Youth and Community Development



Discussions on Maximising Africa's Potential

Each year, the Conference tackles significant macroeconomic and policy issues, e.g.:

- Presentation by McKinsey highlighting Africa's opportunity to serve fast-growing consumer and business markets
- Conversations on the Future of Trade of Africa:
 - Just 20% of Africa's total manufacturing output was exported beyond Africa in the 2010 - 2015 period. Africa represents just 1.5% of global manufacturing exports. What can African countries do to change this trend?
 - Only 10% of Africa's total manufacturing output was traded within Africa in the 2010-2015 period. What role would greater economic integration play in bolstering intra-Africa trade?
 - Africa contains 60% of the world's unutilised but potentially available cropland and the world's largest reserves of several minerals, yet it is responsible for only a very small percentage of global exports for several of these commodities. How does it capture these opportunities?

- 'Hard Talk' discussions about Africa changing from 'gaps' to 'opportunities', 'prospects', and 'ventures'
 - Looking at Africa as a unique market as a whole while considering geographical and demographic nuances
 - The need for mutually beneficial partnerships while investing in the continent
 - Navigating through the risks and complexities to tap into opportunities
 - The investor's search for 'stability', 'predictability' and 'vision'
